**01 MON. Prague - Arrival.**  
**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** Transfer. Evening transfer to Old Town Square.

In the evening, we provide a **transfer to the Old Town Square**. This central location is full of energy and tourist activities. It's a marvellous place to acquaint ourselves with Prague. Several restaurants offering cuisines from around the world will be waiting to delight your taste buds, including Czech, Chinese, Indian and Italian. Return to hotel.

**02 TUE. Prague.**  
**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** City tour of Prague. Visit to Castle. Boat tour along the river.

Today we are visiting this capital city, which is the Baroque jewel of Europe. Our local expert will provide a guided **city tour**, which will include the most outstanding monuments. During the visit we walk through **Prague Castle (admission included)**. Subsequently, we shall take a magnificent **boat tour** along Moldava River. Free time in the afternoon to explore Prague. In the evening, we will enjoy some time off in the historical city center and there will be an opportunity for you to enjoy cuisines from around the world (including Czech, Chinese, Indian and Italian). Return to hotel.

**03 WED. Prague - Lauf - Wurzburg - Frankfurt.**  
**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** Bavarian Germany.

We leave for Germany. In the region of Bavaria, we will see **LAUF AN DER PEGNITZ**, a picturesque little village which stands out for its busy Market Square and Castle. After this we will carry on to **WURZBURG**, with time for lunch and to see this Bavarian city on the banks of the Main, a former bishopric centre and now a very busy university city. Our journey continues towards **FRANKFURT**. Explore the historic centre and choose your favourite restaurant to dine in (from Indian, Oriental, Italian, International, and so on).

**04 THU. Frankfurt - Cruise on the Rhine - Cologne - Amsterdam.**  
**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** Rhine cruise included.

Today we include a small **CRUISE ON THE RHINE**, between the villages of **RUDESHEIM** and **ST. GOAR**; undoubtedly the river's most picturesque sector. After this we will travel to **COLOGNE**, a city which stands out for its immense Gothic cathedral. Then on to Holland. **AMSTERDAM** - arrival at the end of the afternoon - . At the end of the day, you will be taken to Rembrandtplein, one of the busiest squares in the city with plenty of restaurants (Indian, Chinese, Italian, and so on).

**05 FRI. Amsterdam - Volendam - Zaanse Schans - Amsterdam.**  
**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** Picturesque typical village of Volendam. Cheese and wine tasting in a farm. Tour of Amsterdam.

Today we have a very exciting day, we will visit **VOLENDAM**, a very picturesque fishing village. After this we will go to Zaanse Schans to photograph its mill and its typical houses and will visit the cheese farm with cheese and wine tasting included. In the afternoon we include a panoramic tour of **AMSTERDAM** to see its narrow canals, the Dam Platz, its official buildings and parks, and will also see the technique of diamond cutting. Transfer to the red light district, with its liberal values and its many restaurants from all corners of the world. It is very likely that you will have heard about this neighbourhood.

**06 SAT. Amsterdam - Brussels - Bruges - Paris.**  
**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** Feeling Belgium.

We will leave for **BRUSSELS**, and will have time in the Grand Place and take a stop to photograph the Atomium. Later in

**BRUGES**, the marvellous Flemish city known as the "northern little Venice". Time for lunch. Continuation to France. **PARIS**, arrival at the end of the day.

**Recommendation:** If you start or end your trip in Paris, we advise you to book an extra day or two in this city. In this way, you will be able to get to know Euro Disney, Versailles and other places of interest.

**07 SUN. Paris.**  
**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** City tour in Paris. Boat ride along the Seine. Climb to the second floor of the Eiffel Tower. Evening transfer.

A scenic **guided tour** to discover the history, main boulevards and the breath-taking monuments of Paris. We end the visit at the **Eiffel Tower** area. You will have the opportunity to climb up to the second floor of this remarkable metal monument. End your visit with a **boat cruise** along the River Seine, which divides the north of Paris from the south. Enjoy a free afternoon to explore as you choose. At sunset enjoy dinner in "**Quartier Latin**", a very picturesque area of the historic centre where a wide variety of international cuisines await you. Return to hotel.

**08 MON. Paris.-**  
 After breakfast, end of our services.

**08 MON. Paris - Amiens.**  
**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** Amiens Historic Centre.

We go to the centre of Paris, to the area of the Louvre Museum. Free time. If you wish we can accompany you to Benlux, one of the most complete and best-known perfumeries in Paris. At around 5:30 PM we will leave Paris for **AMIENS**, with the highest Cathedral and beautiful historic centre alongside the river. Accommodation in the city.

**09 TUE. Amiens - Eperlecques - Canterbury - London.**  
**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** World War II bunker. Ferry crossing to United Kingdom. Evening transfer to Soho.

We set off to the north of France. In **Eperlecques** we visit a huge bunker in the middle of the forest (**admission included**). From this point, V1 and V2 missiles were fired to the UK. Next, we leave on a ferry across the English Channel to reach **CANTERBURY**, the religious capital of England with a very attractive historic centre. Continuation to London. Tonight sit down for dinner at your preferred restaurant (Indian, Chinese, Thai, International, and so on) in the lively Soho district.

**10 WED. London.**  
**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** Visit London. Changing of the guard. British Museum. English Teatime. Transfer to Camden Town.

Get to know **LONDON** on a locally **guided tour** featuring style, culture and history. See the Houses of Parliament, the River Thames, the Tower of London and Buckingham Palace, where we shall be able to watch the famous "Changing of the Guard" (depending on the season). Afterwards, we go to the British Museum, one of the main and oldest museums in the world, where we can see relics from cultures all around the globe. If you wish, later on, you can go on an optional excursion to the "London Eye" ferries wheel. In the afternoon, at 5pm, after a period of free time, we invite all our travellers to a traditional **Afternoon Tea**. Afterwards, we provide transfer to **Camden**, a district famous for having one of the most varied and extravagant street markets in London. Time for dinner in this area with numerous ethnic restaurants (Indian, Thai, Chinese, International, and so on).

 After breakfast, end of our services.
