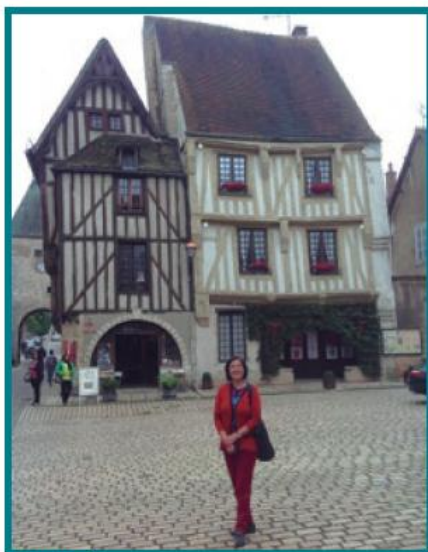

SECRETS IN WHITE AND GREEN

01 MON. Prague - Arrival.

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Transfer. Evening transfer to Old Town Square.

Welcome to **Prague!** At your airport of arrival, we shall be waiting with transport to take you to your hotel. Our guide will greet you at the hotel and provide you with all the necessary information.

In the evening, we provide a **transfer to the Old Town Square**. This central location is full of energy and tourist activities. It's a marvellous place to acquaint ourselves with Prague. Several restaurants offering cuisines from around the world will be waiting to delight your taste buds, including Czech, Chinese, Indian and Italian. Return to hotel.

02 TUE. Prague.

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: City tour of Prague. Visit to Castle. Boat tour along the river.

Today we are visiting this capital city, which is the Baroque jewel of Europe. Our local expert will provide a guided **city tour**, which will include the most outstanding monuments. During the visit we walk through **Prague Castle (admission included)**. Subsequently, we shall take a magnificent **boat tour** along Moldava River. Free time in the afternoon to explore Prague. In the evening, we will enjoy some time off in the historical city center and there will be an opportunity for you to enjoy cuisines from around the world (including Czech, Chinese, Indian and Italian). Return to hotel.

03 WED. Prague - Lauf - Wurzburg - Frankfurt.

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Bavarian Germany.

We leave for Germany. In the region of Bavaria, we will see **LAUF AN DER PEGNITZ**, a picturesque little village which stands out for its busy Market Square and Castle. After this we will carry on to **WURZBURG**, with time for lunch and to see this Bavarian city on the banks of the Main, a former bishopric centre and now a very busy university city. Our journey continues towards **FRANKFURT**. Explore the historic centre and choose your favourite restaurant to dine in (from Indian, Oriental, Italian, International, and so on).

04 THU. Frankfurt - Cruise on the Rhine - Cologne - Amsterdam.

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Rhine cruise included.

Today we include a small **CRUISE ON THE RHINE**, between the villages of **RUDESHEIM** and **ST. GOAR**, undoubtedly the river's most picturesque sector. After

this we will travel to **COLOGNE**, a city which stands out for its immense Gothic cathedral. Then on to Holland. **AMSTERDAM** - arrival at the end of the afternoon - . At the end of the day, you will be taken to Rembrandtplein, one of the busiest squares in the city with plenty of restaurants (Indian, Chinese, Italian, and so on).

05 FRI. Amsterdam - Volendam - Zaanse Schans - Amsterdam.

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Picturesque typical village of Volendam. Cheese and wine tasting in a farm. Tour of Amsterdam.

Today we have a very exciting day, we will visit **VOLENDAM**, a very picturesque fishing village. After this we will go to Zaanse Schans to photograph its mill and its typical houses and will visit the cheese farm with cheese and wine tasting included. In the afternoon we include a panoramic tour of **AMSTERDAM** to see its narrow canals, the Dam Platz, its official buildings and parks, and will also see the technique of diamond cutting. Transfer to the red light district, with its liberal values and its many restaurants from all corners of the world. It is very likely that you will have heard about this neighbourhood.

06 SAT. Amsterdam - Brussels - Bruges - Paris.

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Feeling Belgium.

We will leave for **BRUSSELS**, and will have time in the Grand Place and take a stop to photograph the Atomium. Later in **BRUGES**, the marvellous Flemish city known as the "northern little Venice". Time for lunch. Continuation to France. **PARIS**, arrival at the end of the day.

07 SUN. Paris.

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: City tour in Paris. Boat ride along the Seine. Climb to the second floor of the Eiffel Tower. Evening transfer.

A scenic **guided tour** to discover the history, main boulevards and the breath-taking monuments of Paris. We end the visit at the **Eiffel Tower** area. You will have the opportunity to climb up to the second floor of this remarkable metal monument. End your visit with a **boat cruise** along the River Seine, which divides the north of Paris from the south. Enjoy a free afternoon to explore as you choose. At sunset enjoy dinner in "Quartier Latin", a very picturesque area of the historic centre where a wide variety of international cuisines await you. Return to hotel.

08 MON. Paris.

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Free time in the City of Light.

We go to the centre of Paris, to the area of the Louvre Museum. Free time. If you wish we can accompany you to Benlux, one of the most complete and best-known perfumeries in Paris. Rest of the day free.

09 TUE. Paris - Noyers - Beaune - Lyon.

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Vineyards in Beaune and Bourgogne region.

We travel to the centre of France to the Bourgogne region, famous for its wines. A stop in **NOYERS**, a small mediaeval town classified amongst the prettiest places in France. After this we will visit **BEAUNE** in the centre of the Bourgogne region where its streets full of flowers, its hospice and its wine museum can be reminders of your trip. Time for lunch. **LYON** - Arrival mid-afternoon -, the capital of Roman Gallia on the banks of the Rhône, its historic centre has been declared a World Heritage site. Free time.

10 WED. Lyon - Geneva - Zurich.

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Swiss Landscapes. Centre of Geneva

We have a beautiful stage. We travel to Switzerland. **GENEVA**, arrival. With our guide, go to the Palais des Nations (the United Nations headquarters in Europe) and then to the beautiful "Jardin Anglais" with its flower clock, and admire the "Jet d'Eau", the tallest fountain in Europe. After lunch, we will continue through Switzerland passing the beautiful **Leman and Neuchatel Lakes** (note: depending on the number of travellers from Geneva to Zürich, this trip might be done by train).

11 THU. Zurich - Rapperswil - Zurich.

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Boat trip across Zurich Lake. Journey by train.

With our guide, we will stroll in the most populated city of Switzerland, the financial and cultural capital of the country. The city of banks has twice been declared the city with the best quality of life in the world. After this we will board a **boat for a trip** lasting almost two hours on Zurich Lake. The boat makes brief stops, allowing us to admire the villages on the way. We get off in **RAPPERSWIL**, a small and highly picturesque village overlooked by its medieval castle. We return

to Zurich by **train**, and will see the efficiency and punctuality of the Swiss Railways. Enjoy an evening in the historic centre, next to the lake, where you can dine at your favourite restaurant (Indian, Oriental, Italian, International, Swiss, etc.).

12 FRI. Zurich - Interlaken - Grindelwald - Lucerne - Zurich.

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Admire the fantastic landscapes. Cable car included to Grindelwald first. Lunch included.

Today's stage has beautiful landscapes with high mountains and lakes. Take a stroll through **INTERLAKEN** and follow to **GRINDELWALD** where we will have time for a coffee before taking the **cable car (ticket included) up to Grindelwald first**. We will walk along the path (30 minutes) in which we shall be able to take the "Footbridge over the empty" among the fantastic scenery enjoying glaciers around us. **Lunch included** (vegetarian option available). After that we continue to **LUCERNE**, one of the most beautiful cities in Switzerland. Returning to the heart of Zurich, enjoy an evening at the city's most popular restaurants (Indian, Oriental, Middle Eastern, Swiss, etc.).

13 SAT. Zurich.-

After breakfast, end of our services.
