Day 1

ZAGREB

Wed

Arrival in **Zagreb**. We'll be ready to **transfer you to your hotel**. Our guide will join us with the group from Slovenia around lunchtime. In the afternoon, at around 04:00 p.m. (time may vary), we'll embark on a **panoramic tour with a local guide** (included), giving us the opportunity to admire the city's two hills, the upper town, and the new neighborhoods of Croatia's capital. **Dinner will be included.**

Day 2

ZAGREB - BANJA LUKA - JAJCE - SARAJEVO

Thu

We'll depart early in the morning to travel to **Bosnia**. Border formalities may take some time. As we drive through certain areas, we'll be reminded of the tragic war of the 1990s. Our journey will take us through the majority-Serb territory of Bosnia, with our first stop in **Banja Luka**. Here, you'll have time to explore the capital of the autonomous entity of Republika Srpska, the second largest city in Bosnia after Sarajevo, known for its fortress and Orthodox cathedral. There will be time for lunch. We'll then continue to **Jajce**, arguably the most beautiful town in Bosnia, celebrated for its cultural diversity, mosque, fortress, and impressive **waterfall** (admission included). After some time to explore, we'll proceed to **Sarajevo**, arriving in the evening. You'll have the opportunity to stroll through the historic center and visit the charming Bazaar, an old Ottoman market renowned for its architecture, oriental ambiance, and traditional shops. **Dinner will be included.**

Day 3

SARAJEVO - MOSTAR - DUBROVNIK

Fri

In the morning, we'll enjoy a guided sightseeing tour in **Sarajevo**, a captivating city known as the "Jerusalem of Europe" due to its coexistence of several religions. Mosques, churches, and synagogues showcase its rich religious diversity. We'll explore the old town's strong Ottoman influence, highlighted by a magnificent mosque over 500 years old and a beautiful fountain. After our visit, we'll continue through an area of stunning beauty to **Mostar**, with its enchanting historic center and iconic stone bridge that separates the Orthodox, Muslim, and Catholic communities. You'll have time for lunch and a stroll through the city. We'll then proceed to **Croatia**, where border procedures may take a while. We'll arrive in **Dubrovnik** at the end of the day. **Dinner will be included.**

Day 4

DUBROVNIK

Sat

We'll enjoy a **panoramic tour of Dubrovnik** with a local guide in the morning. We will undoubtedly be in one of the most beautiful cities in Europe, perched on a cliff, surrounded by walls and kissed by the Adriatic Sea. Its intact historic center is a jewel of world architectural heritage. We'll have the opportunity to enjoy a stunning view of the city from a scenic viewpoint along the road. The tour includes tickets to the **Franciscan Monastery**, home to the oldest pharmacy in Europe, and the Assumption Cathedral. We'll also take a **boat trip to Lokrum**, a small island just 15 minutes away that is home to the ruins of an eleventh-century Benedictine monastery, a popular setting for the series *Game of Thrones*. Afterward, you'll have free time to explore at your leisure before returning to the hotel in the late afternoon. **Dinner will be included.**

Note: On some occasions, accommodation may be in Cavtat, a coastal town near Dubrovnik. From November to March, there is no boat service to Lokrum, so we will not visit the island during these months.

Day 5

DUBROVNIK - STON - SPLIT

Sun

We'll set off in the morning, traveling along the stunning Croatian coastline, which features breathtaking seascapes and islands. Our first stop will be in **Ston**, a picturesque town boasting one of the longest walls in the world. As we continue through beautiful landscapes, we'll cross the impressive Pelješac Bridge over the sea. We'll arrive in **Split** at midday and enjoy a **tour with a local guide**, including **admission to Diocletian's Palace**. We'll explore this vast Roman palace, with its labyrinthine streets and stunning sea views. **Dinner will be included.**

Day 6

SPLIT - PLITVICE - OPATIJA

Mon

We'll travel to the interior region of Croatia, passing through beautiful hilly landscapes until we arrive at **Plitvice Lakes National Park**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Here, you'll be able to admire its lakes and waterfalls, walk along the scenic trails, or take a boat ride on the lakes' waters. Tickets are included for either a **boat ride or a train ride**. We will travel to Slovenia's second-largest city, **Maribor**, a city rich in Austrian cultural influence known for its cathedral and castle. Afterwards, we'll go to **Croatia**, arriving in **Zagreb** around 3:00 p.m.

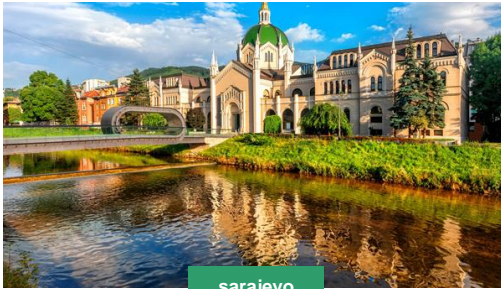

Day 1

ISTANBUL

Mon

Welcome to your tour with Europamundo! We'll transfer you to the hotel and you'll have some free time. In the afternoon, you'll find information about the start of your tour on the boards located at the hotel reception.

Day 2

ISTANBUL

Tue

We'll start with a **panoramic tour of the city**, exploring this unique metropolis that spans two continents. Our tour includes a visit to the **Süleymaniye Mosque**, the largest in Istanbul, as well as stops at the ancient city walls, the Golden Horn, and the bustling fishing district, along with chance to admire the exterior of Hagia Sophia.

As the afternoon draws to a close, we'll arrange a **transfer to Taksim**, the city's most vibrant commercial district. There, you'll have time to dine at one of its many restaurants and hop on the charming old tram that runs through the area. Alternatively, you can visit the nearby Galata Tower.

Day 3

ISTANBUL - ANKARA

Wed

We'll begin our day with a visit to **Topkapi Palace**, the former administrative center of the Ottoman Empire, famous for its stunning courtyards and pavilions (admission included).

Afterward, we'll embark on a **boat trip on the Bosphorus** (tickets included), lasting about two hours on a private boat exclusively for Europamundo travelers. This journey will take us through the strait that connects the Black Sea with the Sea of Marmara, dividing Istanbul between its European and Asian sides. We'll enjoy the lively activity of the strait with its many boats. We'll pass under the two bridges that link Europe and Asia and admire the Sultan's palaces, traditional wooden houses, and Ottoman architecture.

We'll then disembark on the Asian side, in the Uskudar district, from where we'll continue our journey to the Anatolian Peninsula, arriving in **Ankara** in time for **dinner**, which will be included.

Day 4

Thu

We'll visit the impressive **Mausoleum of Ataturk**, the ancient **Ankara Castle**, which dates to the 8th century B.C. We'll also include admission to the **Museum of Anatolian Civilizations**, offering insight into the various cultures that have left their mark on **Turkey**. By late morning, we'll stop at a large shopping mall where you can choose from a variety of dining options at the food court. After lunch, we'll continue our journey to **Cappadocia**, making a stop at the **Salt Lake**, renowned for its breathtaking landscapes. We'll also visit **Hacibektas**, a revered pilgrimage site. Please be mindful of the dress code and maintain silence during our visit, as this sanctuary houses the mausoleum of Hacibektas, a 13th-century Sufi mystic. We'll then proceed to **Nevsehir**, arriving in time for **dinner**, which will be included.

Day 5

CAPPADOCIA

Fri

We'll spend the entire day exploring the incredible region of **Cappadocia**, famous for its lunar-like landscapes, ancient churches, and troglodyte villages. Our adventure will begin in the **Göreme Valley**, where we'll visit the open-air museum and marvel at the rock-cut churches (tickets included). Next, we'll visit **Uchisar**, home to a natural fortress, followed by a visit to **Kaymakli**, an underground city that could once house up to 30,000 people. On our way back to **Avanos**, we'll stop at **Pasabag**, also known as the Fairy Chimneys, where we'll take a walk in this breathtaking natural area. You'll have some free time before we wrap up the day. **Dinner will be included.**

Day 6

CAPPADOCIA - IHLARA - KONYA

Sat

At the far edge of **Cappadocia**, we'll visit the **Ihlara Valley**, famous for its cool waters and its rock-cut churches and villages. Our itinerary includes visits to a 13th-century **caravanserai** and the **Mevlana Mausoleum (Rumi)** in **Konya**, where we'll learn about the Dervish order. **Dinner will be included.** In the evening, we recommend attending a dervish dance performance at the cultural center.

Day 7

KONYA - EGRIDIR - PAMUKKALE

Sun

We'll journey along a scenic route between the lakes, arriving at **Egridir**, a charming town by a large lake, known for its historic walls and mosques. You'll have time to enjoy lunch here. Next, we'll continue to **Hierapolis-Pamukkale**, where the mineral-rich waters have formed the stunning **Cotton Palace** (tickets included). **Dinner will be included.**

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Day 1

SOFIA

Thu

Welcome to Sofia! Upon arrival at the airport, you'll be transferred to your hotel, where you'll receive information about the start of your tour. At approximately 3:00 p.m., we'll begin a **city tour of Bulgaria's capital** and get to know famous sights such as the Alexander Nevsky Cathedral, the Russian Church, the Mosque, and the city's squares and avenues known for their Stalinist architecture. The rest of the day will be free for you to explore at your leisure.

Day 2

SOFIA - BACHKOVO - PLOVDIV

Fri

In the morning, we'll head to **Bachkovo Monastery**, Bulgaria's second most significant monastery, established in the eleventh century. With its three churches, this monastery offers a serene and peaceful atmosphere. We'll then proceed to **Plovdiv**, where **lunch is included** before going on a tour of this city, one of the oldest in Europe. Our tour includes admission to **the Roman Amphitheatre**, **the Old Pharmacy**, and **the Armenian House**.

Day 3

PLOVDIV - KAZANLAK - SHIPKA - ETAR - ARBANASI - VELIKO TARNOVO

Sat

Today's journey will take us through the stunning landscapes of the Balkan Mountains. In the Rose Valley, we'll visit **Kazanlak**, where admission is included to see the replica of the **Thracian Tomb of Kazanlak**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We'll then explore **Etara**, a charming village and ethnographic museum. After **lunch** (included), we'll travel to **Arbanasi**, an ancient trading city known for its fortress-like houses, where we'll visit the **Nativity Church** (admission included). Our day will end in **Veliko Tarnovo**, Bulgaria's former capital, renowned for its picturesque medieval center beside its canyon.

Note: Occasionally, the visit to Arbanasi may take place on Sunday morning.

Day 4

VELIKO TARNOVO - BASARBOVO - BUCHAREST

Sun

We'll travel to **Romania**, stopping along the way to visit the **Basarbovski Monastery**, a pilgrimage site carved into the rock. We'll then cross the border and the Danube, arriving in **Bucharest** around 1:00 p.m. In the afternoon, we'll take a **panoramic tour** of the city, exploring the historic center and the impressive Palace of Parliament. You'll have free time afterward to explore on your own. **Dinner will be included.**

Day 5

BUCHAREST - SINAIA - BRAN - SIGHISOARA

Mon

Today's journey offers stunning scenery as we travel to Transylvania, crossing the Carpathian Mountains and lush forests. In **Sinaia**, we'll take a leisurely stroll through the gardens of the Peles and Pelisor Castles. Our next stop will be the 14th-century **Bran Fortress**, commonly known as **Dracula's Castle** (tickets included). After some time for lunch, we'll continue to **Sighisoara**, a picturesque walled medieval city and UNESCO World Heritage Site. In the evening, we'll enjoy a **special dinner at Count Dracula's restaurant**, located in the house where Vlad the Impaler was born.

Day 6

SIGHISOARA - BIERTAN - SIBIU - HUNEDOARA - TIMISOARA

Tue

In Transylvania, there are many fortified churches in areas that were historically inhabited by people of German origin. Some of these churches are UNESCO World Heritage Sites, and we'll visit one in **Biertan** (tickets included). Afterward, we'll head to **Sibiu**, an important economic and cultural center that once served as the capital of Transylvania. Here, we'll have time to stroll through the lively narrow streets and squares and enjoy lunch. In the afternoon, we'll visit the impressive **Hunedoara Castle** (tickets included), considered the most beautiful castle in Romania. We'll then continue to **Timisoara**, where you'll have time to explore the city's elegant central squares.

Day 7

TIMISOARA - BELGRADE

Wed

We'll depart for **Serbia**, crossing the border and traveling for about 3 hours before reaching **Belgrade**. In this lively capital, situated at the confluence of the Danube and the Sava, we'll enjoy a **panoramic city tour** and explore the bustling city center, see the parliament, and stroll through Kalemegdan Fortress. The tour also includes a visit to the **Museum of Yugoslavia**, where Tito's Mausoleum is located. In the afternoon, you'll have free time to explore the city at your leisure.
