Entrance to Blue Lagoon and Frederiksberg Castle, The Cathedral, Viking Ship Museum, Kon-Tiki Museum, Akershus Fortress. Northern Lights Tour

ITINERARY

DAY 01 MANILA - COPENHAGEN

Assemble at the airport for your flight to Copenhagen. Enjoy in-flight meals and entertainment.

DAY 02 ARRIVE COPENHAGEN (LD)

Welcome to Copenhagen! Upon airport arrival, meet your local representative and go directly to the restaurant for lunch. Afterwards, start your comprehensive tour featuring the Church of Our Saviour, and the Stock Exchange on the way to Christiansborg Palace, where you visit the elegant Royal Reception Rooms. Drive past the National Museum and the Royal Theater and stop for picture-taking of Amalienborg Palace, Nyhavn, then view the Little Mermaid sitting on a rock in the harbor - the statue inspired by Hans Christian Andersen's sad fairytale. Later, visit the Rosenberg Castle and Treasury. Hotel check-in. Dinner

DAY 03 COPENHAGEN - OVERNIGHT CRUISE - OSLO (BLD)

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Full day excursion to North Zealand – it has everything for the nature enthusiast- deep woodlands, open landscapes and varied coastlines. It's also an ancient playground of royalty and there are many castles and manors that you can visit. The first destination is Elsinore, known locally as Helsingor, where you will find the historic Kronborg Castle (Hamlet Castle) - a UNESCO World Heritage Site. After lunch at a local restaurant, proceed to the next destination nearby, the small market town of Hillerod, and you'll see the magnificent Frederiksberg Castle. The building gives the town an undeniable wow factor, with many visitors referring to it as the 'Nordic Versailles'. Then you will board the DFDS for an overnight cruise to Oslo, with dinner onboard.

DAY 04 OSLO (BLD)

Full day sightseeing of Oslo with entrance to The Kon-Tiki Museum and Viking Ship Museum, as well as entrance to Oslo Cathedral, Oslo City Hall, and Oslo Opera House. In the afternoon, continue the tour that includes entrance to Akershus Fortress, located in the city centre, a great place to discover Oslo's history, and to enjoy the day. The building of Akershus Castle and Fortress was commenced in 1299 under king Hákon V. The medieval castle, which was completed in the 1300s, had a strategic location at the very end of the headland, and had withstood a number of sieges throughout the ages. King Christian IV (1588-1648) had the castle modernised and converted into a Renaissance castle and royal residence.

DAY 05 OSLO - REYKJAVIK – Northern Light Hunt (BD)

Hotel breakfast. Then transfer to the airport for your flight to Reykjavik. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. Reykjavik is Iceland's largest city. With approximately only four hours of daylight in winter time, it has a mysterious yet dynamic atmosphere, while in summer it is bustling and full of energy, with almost 24 hours of daylight. In the evening, go for a hunt of the elusive **Aurora Borealis**. **Note: The tour is done by bus. There is no guarantee that the Northern Lights will appear.**

DAY 06 REYKJAVIK - GOLDEN CIRCLE ROUTE (BLD)

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Full day excursion to the spectacular Golden Circle with English Speaking Guide. The wide open landscapes are like nothing you've ever seen before. Actively volcanic, this inland route is a mass of waterfalls, glaciers, geyser, love fields, and of course, those volcanoes. Morning drive over to Hellisheioi plateau to Hverageroi, where plants, vegetables and flowers are grown in huge greenhouse, heated by natural thermal water. Then to Skalholt, site of an ancient bishopric. Then continue to Gullfoss, the Golden Waterfall, one of the most impressive waterfalls in Europe. Only few minutes driver from Gullfoss is the most active geysers in the area, Strokkur, spouting up to 30meters. After lunch, onwards to Thingvellir, a remarkable geological site and the most historic site on the island. Thingvellir is the site of the world's oldest democratic parliament founded in 930. Thingvellir, located by Lake Thingvallvatn, the largest lake on the island, is now a National Park. The beautiful canyon running through the park is actually the meaning point of two of the earth's tectonic plates, and pingvellir's combination of natural phenomena and historical significance make it inseparable. Return to Reykjavik. Dinner at local restaurant.

DAY 07 REYKJAVIK - BLUE LAGOON (BLD)

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy the morning sightseeing tour of Reykjavik. Lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon, enjoy one of Iceland's most popular sights, the "Blue Lagoon", for a relaxing swim in geothermal water. The Blue Lagoon express is not to be missed while you are in Iceland. The Blue Lagoon's warm water and natural active ingredients, mineral salts, silica and blue green algae help you relax and unwind while the blue lagoon white silica mud gently cleanses and exfoliates the skin. The mineral salts balance and relax body and soul.

DAY 08 REYKJAVIK - STOCKHOLM (BLD)

Boxed breakfast at 4:30 AM. Then transfer to the airport for flight to Stockholm. Upon arrival, meet local representative and transfer to restaurant. Rest of the afternoon is free time. Dinner.

DAY 09 STOCKHOLM (BLD)

Breakfast in the hotel. Full day sightseeing tour which includes Entrance to the Royal Palace, the City Hall, and Vasa Museum.

DAY 10 STOCKHOLM - MANILA

Hotel breakfast. Free time until check-out and pick-up from hotel for your departure flight back to Manila.

DAY 11 ARRIVE MANILA

Arrive in Manila from a memorable and enjoyable trip!
